## BCC Staff:

The Belmont Community Center hire our Program leaders and staff as needed to provide a well supervised and enjoyable environment for each child. The staff must meet our most important requirement, that they truly enjoy children and value each child as a special individual.



## Illness:

If your child is ill they must stay home until they are well enough to participate at the BCC. A child should have a normal temperature for 24 hours before returning to the program. Ill children will be separated from others until picked up. If you choose not to exclude the child, a written note from a physician must be provided. All medications must be signed into the office.

## The BCC goals for children:

To provide organized, supervised activities that offer the participants an opportunity to develop their physical, creative and social skills while learning cooperation and decision making.

These opportunities are provided by choices of indoor or outdoor game, crafts & supervised free play, themed activities, occasional movies and trips to parks. .

Homework club is offered every afternoon for every child.

Children must be able to participate successfully in a 1:15 staff to youth ratio



## General Information

- Children are escorted to school for breakfast when school is in session.
- Children must bring a lunch on No School Fun Days. We provide snacks for the children.
- Notify us if your child is absent or someone else will be picking them up.
- Children must be signed out each day.
- The children are expected to follow rules and participate in planned activities.
- Cell phones must be kept in the office.
- Belmont Community Center follows LPS schedule. If school is called off due to weather, we are also closed.
- BCC reserves the right to suspend any participant who is causing serious problems verbally, physically or injury to any participant or staff. Length of suspension is at the discretion of Center Director. Every situation is unique and we reserve the right to work through the steps of this policy at an appropriate rate for the situation. We take physical aggression very seriously and is grounds for automatic suspension
